- 4. Advocating for historic preservation
- 5. Advocating for a variety of initiatives that will create a clean and safe environment, e.g. air quality, heat island effects
- 6. Advocating for traffic calming and pedestrian safety
- 7. Reviewing procedures and prepping the community for Emergency Response to such things as earthquakes and fires.
