4. Advocating for historic preservation
5. Advocating for a variety of initiatives that will create a clean and safe environment, e.g. air quality, heat island effects
6. Advocating for traffic calming and pedestrian safety
7. Reviewing procedures and prepping the community for Emergency Response to such things as earthquakes and fires.
